The electronic presentation should include an introductory slide/paragraph with a short outline about the work contained therein. Art scholars should also provide a reference from their Head of Art or Art teacher at their present school.
- **Performing Arts Scholars (Dance & Drama)**. **External candidates** must provide a reference from their Head of Department, Head Teacher or Dance/Drama teacher. **Internal candidates** should seek a reference from an external source eg Dance or Drama teacher. **All** applicants should write a short personal statement outlining their enthusiasm, enjoyment and appreciation for dance/drama.
- **Music Scholars** must provide a report for their principal instrument from their instrumental teacher and a reference from their Head of Music or Head Teacher at their present school. In addition, they should write a short personal statement outlining their enthusiasm, enjoyment and appreciation for music.
- **Sport Scholars**. This form is for **Criteria 02 & Criteria 03 Sport Scholarship** applications only. Year 7 will have the opportunity to apply for a Criteria 01 Sport Scholarship in the Summer Term 2026.
