She works with teams around the world to drive Always' mission to help stop the drop in confidence that so many girls experience at puberty. This is done with programs aimed to tackle societal barriers to girls' confidence, provide puberty and confidence education to children, parents and teachers, and enable access to period products.

She has led award-winning campaigns including the #LikeAGirl Campaign, the global Always #EndPeriodPoverty program and the Always School Education Program, which reaches over I8million people each year. Prior to working for Always & Whisper, Charlotte worked for a small NGO in El Salvador on community-based projects.
