JOB PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW

This is an exceptional opportunity to join a friendly team working in an ISI-rated 'Outstanding' Nursery.

As a Nursery Practitioner, you'll play a vital role in delivering outstanding care and education for nursery children. You'll work closely with your room team to create a stimulating environment that supports each child's learning journey, following the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework and our child-led 'in the moment' planning approach.

The Nursery is located in a spacious building in the heart of St Gabriel's school, with specific rooms for Babies, Toddlers and Pre-school children, as well as large dedicated outdoor spaces for each of these groups.

- Act as a Key Person for a group of children, supporting their development and maintaining accurate records via iConnect
- Engage in play-based learning and promote progress across all areas of development
